### Chromebook Non-Refundable Insurance Policy

Kennett Public Schools is self insuring our 1:1 computer project. At the beginning of each academic year, we will take up a mandatory \$35 non-refundable insurance fee for accidental damage caused to the Chromebook. The school district will be the one to determine if the damage was accidental. The Chromebooks will not be checked out to the students until we receive this deposit.\* Any Chromebook damaged over half the initial value will be replaced with a replacement Chromebook. Out-of-Pocket Costs are due at the time of pickup after repair. Loaner Chromebooks will be provided during the school day through the library and returned there before dismissal.

Things not covered under the insurance policy.

1. Any intentional act to damage the Chromebooks.
2. Failure to provide adequate protection for the device, like using non-approved carrying cases.
3. Theft not accompanied by a police report.
4. Any additional damage due to failure to report damage to the Chromebook to the KMS Librarian.
5. Tampering with the Chromebook or Chrome OS operating system.
6. Lost Chromebook.
